Valid only for rentals occurring within South Sudan.

ENGLISH VERSION

1. National Legal Basis Relevant South Sudanese laws: • Civil law principles (Transitional Constitution + general contract doctrines) • Contract Act (based on mixed common-law and civil-law principles) • Consumer protection rules — no unified nationwide statute • Electronic Transactions & Digital Commerce — emerging framework • Product Safety & Standards — South Sudan National Bureau of Standards (developing) • Civil Procedure Act (varies by court level) Jurisdiction: typically the court where the rental occurs. Private rental agreements are valid if parties consent and terms are lawful.
2. Tax and Reporting Rental income is taxable. No nationwide VAT system implemented. General guidelines: • Business income tax may apply depending on local rules • Record keeping recommended: minimum 5 years
3. Liability and Insurance Liability requires: • negligence or fault • provable actual damage • causation Gross negligence or intentional acts cannot be excluded. Template limits (unless overridden by mandatory law): • USD 270 per rental • USD 900 for Mobility Recommended insurance: • Public liability insurance (where available) • Equipment/business insurance
4. Consumer Rights & Withdrawal No 14-day EU-style withdrawal rule. Refund rules: • Before handover: according to agreement • After handover: only if item is defective, unsafe or unusable
5. Data Protection No comprehensive national data-protection law. General confidentiality norms apply. Safe Standard® stores no personal data; Stripe processes all payments externally.
6. Enforcement & Cross-Border Cases Handled by local civil courts. Foreign judgments require recognition through local procedure. Arbitration permitted if both parties agree in writing.
7. Use of Templates in South Sudan Annex is internal reference only. Steps: 1. Rental Agreement (Country: South Sudan) 2. Focus Checklist at handover 3. Photo Rule — No notes = No damage = No photos 4. Damage Invoice if required 5. Annex is NOT shared with the renter.
